Submission guidelines and instructions for Student Awards

Referring to the [MGF7 Mission and key topics](#), participants in the Student Awards are required to submit both an Abstract and a Poster of their works by **8th January 2024**.

By the end of January, the ten finalist Posters nominated for Awards will be announced to the participants.

ABSTRACT

Abstract must contain the **objectives**, the **methodologies adopted** and the **results** of the work presented, and it must be **at least 300**, and **no more than 500** words long.

The file must be written in **English** and include **up to five (5) keywords**.

Please, edit the Abstract document using the **provided [Abstract template](#)**.

POSTER

Poster should illustrate the most innovative aspects of the work presented. **Contents are free to choose**, aiming at the **most expressive way to communicate** the topics of energy transition and carbon-neutral Mediterranean cities.

Format: **ISO A1 - vertical** (594 x 841 mm)

How to submit the Abstract and the Poster

In order to submit the Abstract and the Poster, participants are required to register in the [MGF User Area](#):

1. Provide personal data and create a personal profile;
2. Go to *Abstract submission*;
3. Insert Abstract's title;
4. Select (*special*) *STUDENT AWARDS* in the MGF7's sessions menu or check the box 'I would like to apply for the MED GREEN Forum Student Awards';
5. Upload the Abstract and the Poster as two separate **PDF files**.
